Can a food service establishment provide another beverage if requested by a customer?

Yes, if a customer requests a different beverage or size, the food service establishment may provide one.

What happens if an establishment does not comply with this law?

The Health Department may issue a summons, subject to fines, to any food service establishment that does not comply with this law. The penalty cannot exceed \$200.

Do violations of this requirement count toward an establishment's letter grade?

No, a violation of this law does not count toward an establishment's letter grade.
